AMA-ICHI 15 Stages (8Routes,7climbs)

Let's complete the whole 15 stages of "AMA-ICHI" that you can fully enjoy the sea and mountains in Amakusa.

1, OHYANO-Healing Route (49.3km)

The fully enjoyable course to go around the Ohyano Island while visiting amazing view points.

2, DRAGON Route (19.2km)

Traveling the fishing villages in Ryugatake, Kuratake, and Sumoto area, and you can experience perfect course for cycling.

3, HIMEDO Coast Route (10.5km)

Riding a bicycle while enjoying the peaceful scenery of the ocean. This route has smooth road and suitable for cycling beginners.

4, Orange-line Route (23.2km)

23kilo-meter tough course but it shows you the glorious view of Kami-Shima in Amakusa.

5, HAIYA Route (30.5km)

31kilo-meter Course: Crossing the Haiya Bridge over the sea and looking around Oniki to Uchinohara area.

6, BIG-Challenge Route (13km)

This is the great route selected as the course of the Japan National Athletic Meet. You can get clear spring water after climbing up to the highest point of this route.

7, Dolphin Route (29.5km)

Almost 30kilo-meter course from the Onike Port to Kikai ga Ura. You may enjoy some natural products like Oppai Iwa(Breast-shaped Rock).

8, AMAKUSA Sunset-line Route (34.2km)

The long route along the West Coast in Shimo-shima and visiting some historical heritages; Sakitsu Cathedral, Oe Church, or Jusan-butsu Park.

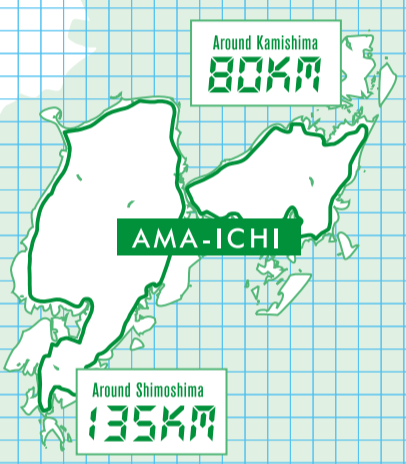
To prevent yourself from being in an accident, try making a small company when you travel those routes in a group.
